The workshops are open to children who stammer between the ages of 8 - 14 and have been running successfully for over 12 months.

They will run for 9 weeks starting on Thursday 4th February and will be held in the Gaiety School of Acting, Sycamore St, Dublin 2. Classes will be from 5:00 p.m. – 6:45 pm each Thursday.

These workshops will be part funded by the ISA through grant aid from the HSE. There will be a registration charge of €35 for each child to cover the cost of administration; this works out at just €4 per week which we think represents excellent value.
